



This 3 ½ hour course includes

- Explanation of the consequence of driving a defective or poorly maintained vehicle. Case histories and a list of possible sanctions, prohibitions or fines for doing so.
- Advice on the dangers of driving a defective or poorly maintained vehicle
- Explanation of the requirement for companies to properly maintain vehicles
- Advice on conducting thorough vehicle checks. Including:
 - Fluids
 - Connections
 - Windscreen and mirrors
 - Panels, locks and doors
 - Tyres, condition and tread
 - Lights
 - Seat belts and interior fittings
- Advice on common defects on vehicles
- Common defects due to maintenance issues
- Common defects due to accidental damage
- The necessity to report defect

The course includes a practical exercise and progress confirmation quiz.
